

## MVHRA Wins 2023 SHRM Pinnacle Award for Exceptional HR Program

Award Initiatives Focused on Community Outreach, Education and Membership

OHIO - DAYTON, MVHRA was awarded the 2023 SHRM Pinnacle Award during the Nov. 17 SHRM Volunteer Business Leaders Meeting in Washington D.C. in recognition of its high achievements advancing the profession of human resources.

The Pinnacle Award is the most prestigious honor SHRM state councils and chapters can receive. Created in 1991, it recognizes innovative projects created and implemented by SHRM affiliates. MVHRA was one of twelve human resource organizations which included nine chapters and three state councils —out of more than 600 —from across the country to win the award in 2023.

The awards, created by SHRM in 1991 come with \$1,000 and a crystal plaque. This year's awards were sponsored by 4019k) Solutions by Raymond James.

The MVHRA Mentoring Program is designed to serve the HR professional by providing skills development and professional growth opportunities to our members.
